Credit offtake outstrips deposit growth

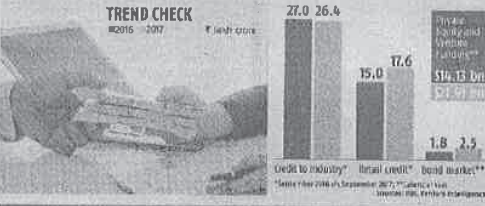

It is the fifth bi-monthly monetary policy conference, Reserve Bank of India (RBI) Governor Urjit Patel said that the recent data concerning flows of financial resources suggests that the Indian economy was beginning to see credit growth.

After more than a year, in November, the credit growth rate outstrips the pace of deposit growth. While deposit growth as of the fortnight ended November 10 was 8.1 per cent, credit grew at 8.6 per cent.

Credit growth was below five per cent in February this year. However, it initially fell by the corporate sector because it was down to economic growth, disinvesting companies from investing in fresh projects, while banks shied away from giving credit to companies.



"We are seeing a small pickup in credit growth; proposals are coming from the renewable sector," said Venkat Nagawari, deputy managing director of global markets at State Bank of India, the country's largest lender.

The space left by banks has been filled by other sources, such as banks, private equity funds, and non-banking finance companies (NBFC), which have become significant lenders to the commercial segment. Well-rated companies continue to tap the bond market,

while companies with the rating of 'A' and lower have to borrow from banks because bonds are too costly for them.

The latest data on NBFC credit growth is not available, but as of September, NBFCs clocked 13 per cent growth in credit. NBFCs in 2015-16 disbursed 284,000 crore an additional crore as of September 29.

in 2016, private equity and venture capital funds had invested around 24.3 billion in the corporate sector, and had increased to about \$21.9 billion in 2017 so far, according to Venture Intelligence, which tracks private equity finances and investments in the country.

Market sources say last year, non-financial corporate firms raised 1.8 lakh crore from the bond markets while this year they have about 2.5 lakh crore. Going by the RBI data, retail loans prop up banks' loan growth numbers. Retail loans grew 16.8 per cent year-on-year to 17.55 lakh crore at the end of September 2017.

Complications in GST anti-profiteering rules

The official form for making complaints under the anti-profiteering mechanism in the goods and services tax (GST) regime defers the purpose—to help consumers get the full benefit of tax cuts and input tax credits.

The form, APAF-1, requires a consumer to file in detail the cost structure of the company against which a complaint is made for profiteering. Also, details on sale price, taxes, both pre-GST and post-GST, benefits of input tax credits, etc.

Rajeev Dinesh, partner with consultancy Dinesh India, asked how consumers could be expected to know all these details, particularly of cost structures, when even many industries in such a company wouldn't be aware of these. Ashishank Jain, tax partner with KV India, said it was expected that a separate application might be needed for each good or service in reference to which anti-profiteering is alleged.

Pratik Jain of consultancy PwC India agreed the level of information asked for in the anti-profiteering form seemed too detailed for a common citizen. "It might be more realistic for consumers to reach out to the GST rate cut, to consumers. B.N Sharma, additional secretary in the department of revenue, is chairman of the Authority.

In its latest meeting in November, the GST Council had cut rates on a little over 300 items. As many as 276 items came out from 28 per cent to 18 per cent, that leaves only 60 items which attract the highest GST rate of 28 per cent.

Also, the tax rate on restaurants, having 18 per cent, was reduced to 12 per cent from 18 per cent.

STAMBLING BLOCK

In addition to the Authority, the institutional mechanism for effective implementation of the anti-profiteering measures constituted in the GST rules consists of a standing committee, state-level screening committees and the Directorate General of Safeguards in the Central Board of Excise & Customs (CBEC). Consumers who say their tax has been no continuous reduction in price may apply for relief to the screening committee in their jurisdiction. After formal review, the screening committee will advise the Director General of Safeguards for a detailed investigation. The findings to go to the Authority.

The screening committee is expected to look into complaints of local nature; the standing committee would concentrate on nationwide cases of unfair practices. Most complaints so far on profiteering with screening committee and the standing committee relate to restaurants and retail stores. Other than the Authority confirms this is a justification to apply anti-profiteering measures, it has the power to order that business concerned to reduce its prices or return the undue benefit availed of, within a period of 100 per cent, to the consumers of the goods or services. If the undue benefit availed is passed on to consumers, it can be ordered to be returned in the form of a refund.

The Authority also has the power to impose a penalty on the defaulting business in event non-compliance of the GST regulation.
