New army chief set to keep up multi-domain capability drive

New Delhi, 14 June

Chief of the Army Staff-designate Lieutenant General Dhiraj Seth, set to take charge on June 30, is expected to maintain the momentum behind the army's capability development and modernisation efforts, having played a role in formulating the force's long-term road map for both.

The Centre on Saturday named Lieutenant General Seth, the current vice chief of the army staff (VCoAS), as the next chief of the army staff (CoAS).

He will assume office in the afternoon of June 30, 2026, when the incumbent, General Upendra Dwivedi, retires. Lieutenant General Seth has served as VCoAS since April 1, 2026.

Lieutenant General Seth's appointment as CoAS comes just over a year after Operation Sindoor, the May 7-10 conflict with Pakistan that witnessed the army employ guided artillery and unmanned systems, aided by artificial intelligence (AI) tools, against both terrorist infrastructure and regular Pakistani military targets. The conflict also brought large-scale "kinetic, non-contact warfare" — centred on the use of missiles, drones and long-range precision weapons to engage targets from a distance — and "cognitive warfare" — the use of information and influence to shape, disrupt or degrade an adversary's decision-making — to the subcontinent.

Lieutenant General Dushyant Singh (retired), director-general of the Centre for Land Warfare Studies, identified accelerating the country's defence transformation as a key objective for Lieutenant General Seth as CoAS.

"As the Indian Army enters a decisive phase of its modernisation journey, Lieutenant General Seth takes over from General Dwivedi, who has set an impressive pace in driving far-reaching reforms. A key architect of this ongoing transformation, Lieutenant General Seth brings proven leadership to steer the army

towards a future defined by seamless jointness, *Atmanirbhar* (self-reliance) in equipment and capabilities, and innovation," he said.

Announcing his appointment, an official release said Lieutenant General Seth's nearly four-decade career had spanned the "operational, strategic, capability development and institutional domains", and that he had contributed "significantly" to enhancing the army's combat effectiveness and furthering its long-term transformation.

Lieutenant General Seth's involvement in the army's capability development and modernisation efforts is evident from the key appointments he has held in the Strategic Planning and Capability Development Directorates, including Colonel Capability Development for Mechanised Forces, Brigadier Perspective Plans and Acquisition, and Additional Director Gen-

eral Capability Development. He has also played a role in shaping the Army's Long Term Perspective Plan (LTPP) and modernisation road map.

The service-specific LTPPs are integrated into the Long Term Integrated Perspective Plan, which spans 15 years and is divided into three five-year Services Capital Acquisition Plans, also known as Defence Plans. These set out the equipment to be acquired by the Services to meet their operational requirements, taking into account resource availability.

The Defence Plans are further broken down into two-year roll-on Annual Acquisition Plans.

Lieutenant General Singh (retired) said Lieutenant General Seth's vision centred on building a world-class, battle-ready force capable of dominating the multi-domain battlespace. "At the core of his agenda is human resource preparedness — ensuring our officers and soldiers are equipped, trained and empowered to tackle both current and emerging defence and security challenges with agility and resilience."

Multi-domain operations involve the integrated employment of capabilities across the land, air, maritime, cyber, space, electromagnetic, information and cognitive dimensions to achieve military objectives.

Lieutenant General Seth's appointment as CoAS comes months after the government approved the army's long-pending proposal to raise integrated battle groups (IBGs), one of more than three dozen organisational reforms cleared over the 15 months leading up to January 2026.

He has previously served as General Officer Commanding-in-Chief of the South Western Command and Southern Command, gaining the rare distinction of commanding two operational commands along the Western Front.

Six strategic breakthroughs place India among elite missile powers

India has consolidated its position as a major military power in South and Southeast Asia by notching up six key milestones in a month that make it one of the few countries capable of building both advanced offensive deterrence and sophisticated defensive missile shields.

The latest achievement came over the weekend when the Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) successfully conducted three consecutive flight tests of two world-class next-generation interceptor missiles and the maiden trial of the Naval Anti-Ship Missile-Medium Range (NASM-MR) from the Integrated Test Range off the Odisha coast.

Defence sources said the twin tests of interceptors (AD-I and AD-II) and the anti-ship missile demonstrated a multi-layered Ballistic Missile

Defence (BMD) shield and India's ability to neutralise long-range threats, including intercontinental ballistic missile, while simultaneously enhancing maritime strike capabilities. "The interceptors successfully engaged their respective targets. The systems have been designed and developed with the latest technologies to address the emerging missile threats," the Ministry of Defence said in a statement.

Defence minister Rajnath Singh hailed the achievement, stating that the success has put India in elite group of nations having ballistic missile defence capabilities to engage missiles up to ICBMs. "These tests have successfully demonstrated multiple crucial technologies bolstering nations defence capabilities against different types of enemy threats," he said on social media platform X.

Describing how a BMD system functions, the sources

cited above said targets are first tracked by radars, which continuously monitor their speed, altitude and trajectory before passing commands to launch the interceptors. Interception is executed in one of two ways — the interceptors either use "hit-to-kill" kinetic energy to physically crash into the threat or detonate the target to destroy or disable it before impact.

Launched in 1999, a year after Pakistan conducted its nuclear test, India's BMD programme has evolved steadily over the last two decades. The DRDO has initiated Phase-III of the programme code named AD-AH and AD-AM following successful completion of the first two phases. The upcoming interceptors will counter cruise missiles, hypersonic glide vehicles and missiles that carry multiple independent nuclear warheads.

LUTYENS' LAND TUSSELE

Jaipur Polo Ground: What the takeover means and what comes next

The central government's takeover of the 15.20-acre Jaipur Polo Ground has brought into focus a broader set of disputes involving some of Lutyens Delhi's longstanding clubs and associations, with the Delhi Gymkhana Club and Race Course Club facing similar action.

Officials of the Land & Development Office (L&DO) under the Union Housing and Urban Affairs Ministry took physical possession of the Race Course area property on Saturday, acting on a May 20 eviction order that said the land was required for a "larger public purpose". The order, however, did not specify how the land would be used.

The Jaipur Polo Ground is the first among the three properties where the Centre has completed the process of taking possession, making it a closely watched case as related litigation continues elsewhere.

Legal battle not over
The Indian Polo Association (IPA), which challenged the eviction order, has termed the action "wrongful, arbitrary

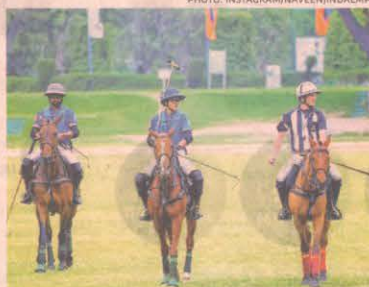

and contrary to law" and said it will pursue legal remedies. "As the matter is subjudice and ongoing, the Association does not propose to comment further at this stage," IPA counsel Major (Retd) Nirvikar Singh further said.

The Delhi High Court had earlier asked a district court to hear the association's plea seeking a stay on the eviction notice. After the district court declined interim relief, the Centre proceeded to take pos-

session of the ground. While the land is now under government control, the legal challenge itself remains pending.

Part of a larger land row
The L&DO has also issued eviction orders to the Delhi Gymkhana Club and Race Course Club, saying the premises are required for a larger public purpose.

In the Gymkhana Club case, the Delhi High Court on

May 26 had taken note of the central government's submission that it would not take forcible possession of the colonial-era club by June 5 while proceedings are pending. The court also declined to interfere with the government's decision to terminate the club's perpetual lease of the 27.3-acre plot, with the matter listed for further hearing later this year.

In the Race Course Club matter, the Delhi High Court last month set aside an order that had stayed a showcause notice linked to the proposed eviction of the club from its 84-acre premises.

What happens next?
The Jaipur Polo Ground takeover shows that the Centre is moving beyond notices and court filings to actual possession in at least one case.

The eviction order referred to a "larger public purpose" without elaborating on the government's plans. That question is likely to gain greater prominence as proceedings involving other Lutyens' Delhi properties move through the courts.

कोणत्याही देशाच्या धोरणात्मक आणि सामाजिक सामर्थ्याचा खरा पाया त्याची अर्थव्यवस्था असते. जगातील सर्वात वेगाने वाढणाऱ्या मोठी अर्थव्यवस्था असा दावा करत भारत स्वतःचे सामर्थ्य कत असा आहे. मात्र, एखाद्या प्रबंध लोकात्मकतेच्या देशासाठी आणि दरदोडी उदरगत्या बाबतीत १४ ते १६ या क्रमांकाच्या असायस असताना ते पुरेसे नाही, भारताचे यापेक्षा अधिक चांगले कामगिरी करण्याची गरज आणि क्षमता देखील आहेत. पंतप्रधानांनी आता 'किमान सरकार, कमाल प्रशासन' या आत्म्या मूळ भूमिकेकडे परत जाण्याची आवश्यकता आहे.

संकटाच्या काळात हे सरकार स्वतःच्या चुकीच्या निर्णयांमध्ये सुधारणा करण्याची क्षमता दाखवत आले आहे. अलीकडच्या काळात मुक्त व्यापार कराराला वेगाने झालेल्या हालचाली, परदेशी गुंतवणूकदारांच्या रोखे गुंतवणूकीवरून कर मागे घेण्याचा निर्णय आणि यथार्थतेने सर्व कर मोडीत काढण्याच्या जोरात आल्या, अधिक उदारमतवादी दिशांची

नरेंद्र मोदी यांनी बवाहलाल नेहरू यांना मागे टाकत, सर्वोच्च काठ पंतप्रधान राहण्याचा बडवाण पटकजातला आहे. गेल्या आठवड्यात माध्यमांमध्ये या बागांनीचीच जोरदार चर्चा होती. मोदी आणि नेहरू यांच्यात तुलना करताना, देशासाठी दोघांच्या योगदानाबद्दल बरीच चर्चा झाली. ही चर्चा आता इथेच थांबून पवित्र्याकडे घाटघालत करण्याची गरज आहे. मोदी यांच्या कार्यकाळातील आणखी तीन वर्षे बाकी आहेत आणि ते २०२९च्या निवडणुकीच्या रिणगात असतील, हे जवळपास निश्चित आहे. कोण जाणे, कदाचित ते २०२६मध्ये मैदानात उतरतीलही. मोदी आणि नेहरू यांच्यात तुलना करताना राजकारणात सक्ति राहतील, असे गृहीत धरून त्यांच्यासमोरील आव्हानांवर चर्चा करायला हवी. त्यातील पाच प्रमुख आव्हानांची यादी मि मांडतो.

यातील पहिले आव्हान म्हणजे मोदींनी भूतकाळाच्या साक्षात्कांडातून स्वतःला मुक्त करायला हवे. यातचचच नेहरू, इंदिरा गांधी किंवा अन्य नेत्यांबरोबर तुलना आता बांधायला हवी. सगळ्या सर्वोच्च काठ निवडून आलेले पंतप्रधान म्हणून मोदी यांची तुलना त्यांच्या १२ वर्षांच्या कार्यकाळात करावे, याच निष्कारण झाली पाहिजे. देशासाठी झालेल्या मोदींसाठीही हाच एकमेव योग्य मार्गदर्शक ठरेल. त्यांना दोषकांड दिव्यातून राखणी वारास निर्माण करायचा असेल, तर ती भारताच्या राजकीय इतिहासातील सर्वात मोठे 'नेहरू-विरोधक' अशी ओळख मिळवून नये; तर ती बारास त्यांच्या स्वतःच्या नावाने आणि स्वतंत्र कार्याचा बळावर उभा राहिल पाहिजे.

सध्याच्या आर्थिक समस्येवर आणि कामकुशल होण्याच्या रण्यार 'दुसरी १९९१ किंवा २०१९मधील आर्थिक समस्या किती वाईट होती, हे विसरला का?' हे उतर फार काळ देता येणार नाही. पंतप्रधान पदावरील ४,३९९ दिवसांच्या विक्रमनंतर मोदी यांच्यासमोरील हेच पहिले सर्वात मोठे आव्हान असणार आहे. इतर काही काळ संतुषाचा पदवार असणाऱ्या कोणत्याही राजकीय नेत्यापुढे मोदी यांनाही अनेक आव्हानांचा सामना करावा लागेल. यातील कोरना, जुलूम दुडू आणि परिवम आशियातील युद्धे ही तीन आव्हाने जागतिक स्वरूपाची होती. त्यांच्या दुसऱ्या मोठीय आव्हानाची निर्मिती या तीन संकटातून झाली आहे. अमेरिकेचे अस्स्य डोनाल्ड ट्रम्प यांच्यासारख्या प्रमाणातील आणि अनिश्चित नेत्यांशी पुढील काळात कामे कुळवून घ्यायचे, हा प्रश्न आहे. आतापर्यंत मोदींनी हा प्रश्न संयमाने आणि संतुलितपणे हाताळला आहे. युरोपीय देश आणि अमेरिकेच्या मिश्रदेशांनी स्वतंत्रपणे घोरणांचा धडा घेत, कोणत्याही विधानातील त्वरित प्रतिक्रिया न देता शांत राहून कामे मागील अवलंबून आहे. यातून व्यवहारकीय राजकारणाची पट्टा आणखी टाळून होईल आणि त्याचे अस्स्यभारण करत करू शकतो. इराण युद्धाने राखवून दिल्याप्रमाणे भारताने अमेरिका, इराक आणि संयुक्त अरब अमितीत यांची बाजू निवडली आहे, हे प्रत्यक्ष कृतीवून दिसते. आता व्यापार कराराचा प्राथमिक

युद्ध संपले किंवा सुरू राहिले तरी पश्चिम आशियातून होणारा पुर्वत वहायला तीन ते सहा महिन्यांच्या काळातच लागणारा असल्याने सध्या सुवाचस्थेतील प्रश्न तीव्र होणार आहेत. त्यात भर पडली आहे ती विवादी आणि तरुणांच्या प्रश्नांची.

राष्ट्रीय राजकारणातील सर्व प्रमुख राजकीय पक्षांसाठी जूराचा माहिना नेहमीच संकटांचा आणि गणाबाचा ठरला आहे. विशेषतः केंद्रात सत्तेत राहिलेल्या पक्षात आणि किरीसासाठी. गेल्यावर्षी जून महिन्यात अल्पदबावातून लंडनच्या दिशेने उडालेले बोईंग विमान आख्या ३८ सेकंदांमध्ये कोसळल्यामुळे उडवलेले राष्ट्रीय दुःख पंचवट आगीबाबल्या कड आठवणांचा 'सुवर्ण महोत्सव' पार पाडणाऱ्या मोदी सरकारातील यंत्रणा 'अधिक मासा सौभत संपलेला जूनचा पूर्वाह्न बाहुतांना संकल्प शिवाला नेणार ठरला. पण मोदी सरकारपुढे शिथिल आयातदार उनी ठाकलेली आव्हाने घेता जूनचा उत्तरार्ध तेवढाच सुखद उरला, याची शाक्यता नाही.

देशासाठी आणि मोदी सरकारच्या दृष्टीने बकरणी सध्यांमिती शांत आणि समाधानकारक भासात असली, तरी आगामी काळात उदरगत्याचा गंभीर संकटांचे बोईबाजूनी दाटणारे डग कडात-नकडात राड होत चालले आहेत. हे डग खरिण्याचे पेशीसाठी सभ झालेल्या भारतावर पंचवट्युटी करणारे नाहीत. उडत संपूर्ण देशावर ओडवणारे 'फ्ले नि'चे संकट अधिक तीव्र करून समस्या बाढविणारे आहेत. पश्चिम आशियातमध्ये २६ फेब्रुवारीपासु अमेरिका-इराक-इराक आणि इराण

अमेरिकेकडे नोंदविलेला नोंदविलेला निषेध सर्वसाधारणपणे आणि विरोधी पक्षांना खंबळता नाही. पंतप्रधान मोदी यांनी या धटिनेत निषेध केला नाही म्हणून सरकार समर्थकांसह राहुल गांधी, मल्लिकार्जुन खर्गे तीव्र प्रतिक्रिया व्यक्त करत आहेत. न्यायव्यवस्थेचे देवयानी खोत्रांघडे यांच्याशी अमेरिकेने केलेल्या असभ्य वर्तनाच्या प्रत्युत्तात मनमोहन सिंग सरकारने दिल्लीतील अमेरिकी दूतावासचे सुरक्षाकवच हटविले होते. तशीच अमेरिकेला खागत राहिले अशी कृती प्रतिक्रियेदातल भारतात करायची, अशी मागणी होत आहे. नोंद-युद्धी आणि सीबीएसईच्या प्रशासकीय गैरव्यवहारीची जबाबदारी स्विकारून शिक्षणमंत्री धर्मेंद्र प्रधान यांनी राजीनामा द्यावा किंवा त्यात बदल करायला यावे, म्हणून 'कॉलेज जनाता पार्टी'ने दिल्लीतील ६ नवव्या अंशालापाठोपाठ आठवड्याभराने पुणे, लखनौ, अमृतसर, हैदराबाद, बंगळूर, जयपुरमध्ये विद्यार्थी आंदोलनेच आयोजन करून २० जून रोजी दिल्लीत पुन्हा आंदोलन छेडण्याची तयारी चालविली आहे. दुसरीकडे याच मुद्द्यावरून कॅम्पस, युवक कॅम्पस आणि प्युअर्सयुअर्सही देशात टिकाटिकाची आंदोलने करून व योजे काढत मोदी सरकारवर टीकादार आणला आहे. विद्यार्थी आणि बेरोजगारांच्या मुद्यावरून राहुल गांधी यांनीही मैदान उतरून कोंटा (राज्यव्याप), अलाहाबाद (उत्तर प्रदेश), पाटणा (बिहार) व दिल्लीमध्ये विद्यार्थ्यांची संवादा सामर्थ्याची सज्जता केली आहे.

खाक झाल्यामुळे मुख्य निवडणूक आयुक्त जगेशकुमार यांच्या नेतृत्वाखालील कुमालेच्या वाङ्मयत उदरगत्या नैसर्गिक निवडणूक आयोगाविरुद्धीय संशय अनेक पटींनी वाडला आहे आणि इन्धीएस चरमसत होण्यापाठ्या घातघाताची विविध तपास पेशकारांचे चौकशीची स्थापना करून सरकारी तपास अग्रत्यक्षणे दुडोवर टिळा आहे. दुसरीकडे कॅम्पसच्या मीनाबाी नटराज यांचा राख्यसमा निवडणूकीचा उमेदवारी अर्ज ज्या एकनाची पद्धतीने निवडणूक आयोगाने आणि सर्वोच्च न्यायालयाने फेटाळला त्यामुळे विरोधाभासील अस्तौय शिरोला पोहोचला आहे. परकी चलन वाचणे म्हणून देशवासीयांना वर्षभर परदेश दूर न करण्याचे आवाहन केलायवारी केंद्रीय मंत्रिमंडळातील विचो वन्यायजी अर्जुनरम मेघवाल यांनी सर्वोच्च व उच्च न्यायालयातील न्यायमूर्ती आणि बरिष्ठ वकीलांची लंडनमध्ये बॅंदिटनीत रस्थां परतून पंतप्रधान नरेंद्र मोदी यांच्या आवाहानात भारतीयेण हताळ फासण्याची कायमे केली आहे.

या पारबन्धुनर प्रक्रममध्ये उठे अग्लेल्या जी-७ देशांच्या शिखर परिषदेत पंतप्रधान मोदी आणि अमेरिकेचे राष्ट्राध्यक्ष डोनाल्ड ट्रम्प यांच्या पेटोडके देशासाठीचे लक्ष लागलेले असेल. गेल्या वर्षी याने १.५ ते १.७ जूनच्या काळातवारीत केंद्रांमामे झालेल्या जी-७ देशांच्या शिखर परिषदेत पंतप्रधान मोदी आणि राष्ट्राध्यक्ष ट्रम्प सभागी होऊनही त्यांची धेट धेट होऊ शकली नव्हती. मोदी-ट्रम्प यांची

शेवटीक धेट १ फेब्रुवारी २०२५ रोजी ब्रॉडेट हाजमस्ये झाली होती. त्यानंतर पुलाबळून भरपूर पाणी वाहून गेले आहे. ट्रम्प दुसऱ्यांदा राष्ट्राध्यक्षपदी विजयी होण्यापूर्वी होते तसे मंत्री आणि सल्लागारचे भारत-अमेरिका संबंध राहिलेले नाही. उजव देत असेल तरी त्यांच्या संबंधात सीईए नेवावरण आहे. आणि गणात कमलाची आहे.

पहलामुदाम्या अतिथी हल्ल्याच्या अनुसूततात भारतात पाकिस्तानावर केलेली 'अपरेशन सिद्ध' ची खबरदारी कावाही आणि हतधेपानी रोखल्याचा ट्रम्प यांचा दावा, गेल्या सोळा महिन्यांमामुन तातकाळत असलेला भारत-अमेरिका अंतर्गत व्यापार करार, ट्रम्प यांनी भारताविरुद्धीय केलेली आक्षेपाई विधाने यामुळे निर्माण झालेली कडुता लोच संणणार नाही. अशा परिस्थितीत भारत-अमेरिका अंतर्गत व्यापार करारवर प्रक्रममध्ये शिक्कापोंवत होऊन उभारू शकतात बाजू दुडुटी झाल्यास त्याचे तीव्र पडदार तयार शकतात. संपलेल्या 'अधिकमासा' नंतरच्या उर्वरित जून पवित्र्यातील मोदी सरकारला या आव्हानांना सामोरे जावे लागणार आहे.
